Call for Abstracts

The [2024 Florida Association of Environmental Professionals Symposium](#) (April 25 & 26, 2024) is accepting abstracts on topics that will be of interest and provide education to environmental professionals. Topics of interest may include Section 404 – WOTUS, Listed Species Updates, Mitigation Banking, Environmental Restoration, Transportation / Infrastructure, Due Diligence, PFAS/Emerging Contaminants, State of Florida Legislative Updates, Sensitive Land Management, Contaminated Site Cleanup / Brownfields, Stormwater, Geology, Environmental Compliance, Sustainability, GIS Applications, Solid Waste, New Professionals, and Students Poster.

FAEP is a certified provider of continuing professional education. Therefore, abstracts that are technical in nature will be given strong preference over an abstract that is considered more of a marketing piece for a given company or technology. Guidelines & Information for Abstract Submission

- Abstracts should be 500 words in length or less and should be submitted using the [2024 FAEP Symposium Abstract Submission Google Form](#) no later than **January 26, 2024**, to guarantee consideration by the Committee.
- In addition to the answers to the questions in the [2024 FAEP Symposium Abstract Submission Google Form](#), presenters should also be prepared to upload a Word format file (1MB or less) containing the following information:
 - Title of the presentation;
 - Summary of the presentation (approximately 500 words or less);
 - Presentation length;
 - The name, email and phone number for the person submitting the abstract and any co-presenters (if known); and

- A brief bio of the presenter (and co-presenters if known).
- New Professionals Category, we are seeking those professionals that have been an Environmental Professional for less than 5 years. The abstract should pertain to their past/current work in the environmental industry with a presentation length being targeted for 10 minutes,
- Speakers will receive a discounted speaker rate (\$150) to register for the full Symposium. Each speaker will be responsible for any additional expenses required to attend, such as travel or lodging.
- The FAEP Conference Committee will notify you if your abstract has been accepted no later than March 8, 2024.
